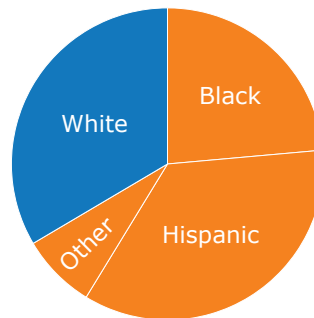

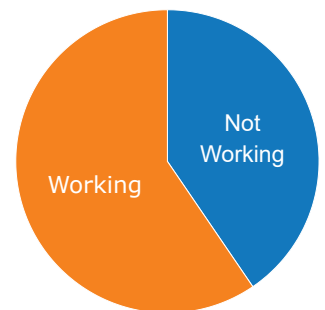

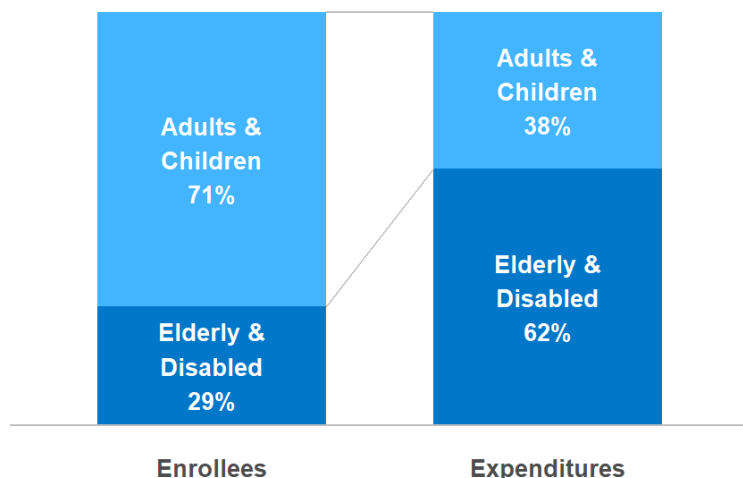

Medicaid Enrollees & Expenditures in FL

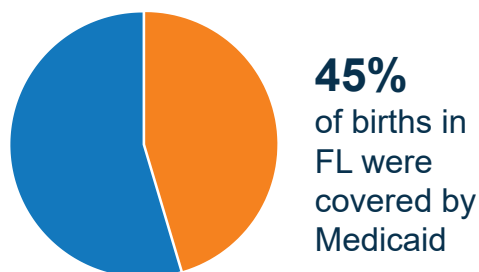
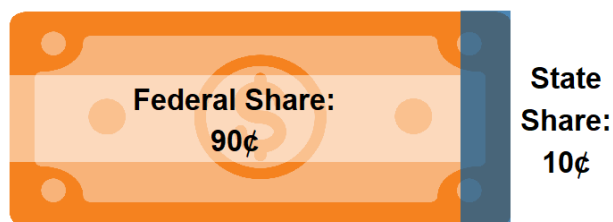
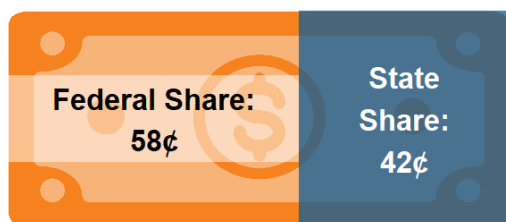


Total FL Medicaid Spending by Service: \$28.1 billion



In FL, the federal government pays **58%** of the cost of traditional Medicaid plus a 5 percentage point increase tied to the unwinding of the continuous enrollment provision that phases down and ends on December 31st, 2023

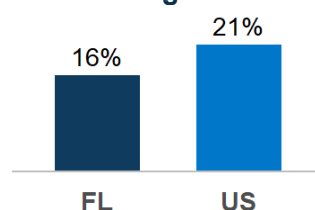
If FL expanded Medicaid, the federal government would pay **90%** of the costs of the Medicaid expansion, plus FL would see a net gain of **\$1.8 billion** over 2 years in ARPA fiscal incentive payments



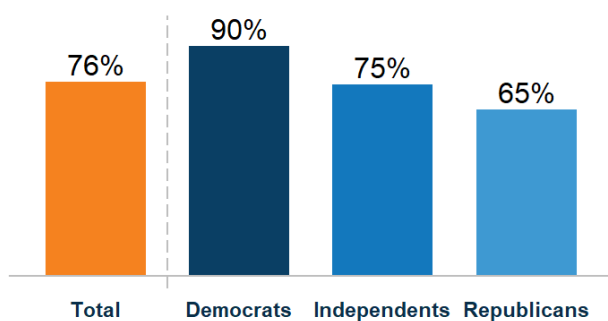
Florida **has adopted** the Medicaid 12-month postpartum coverage extension
