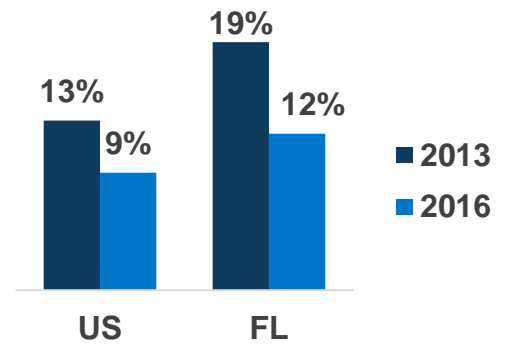

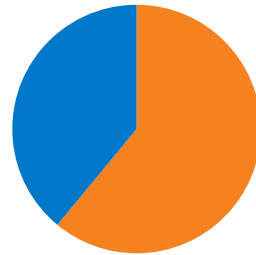

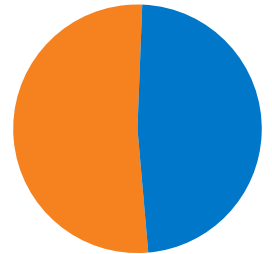

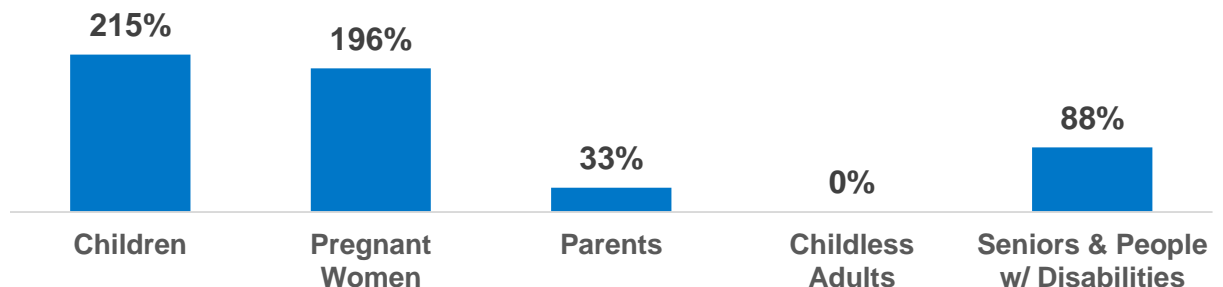

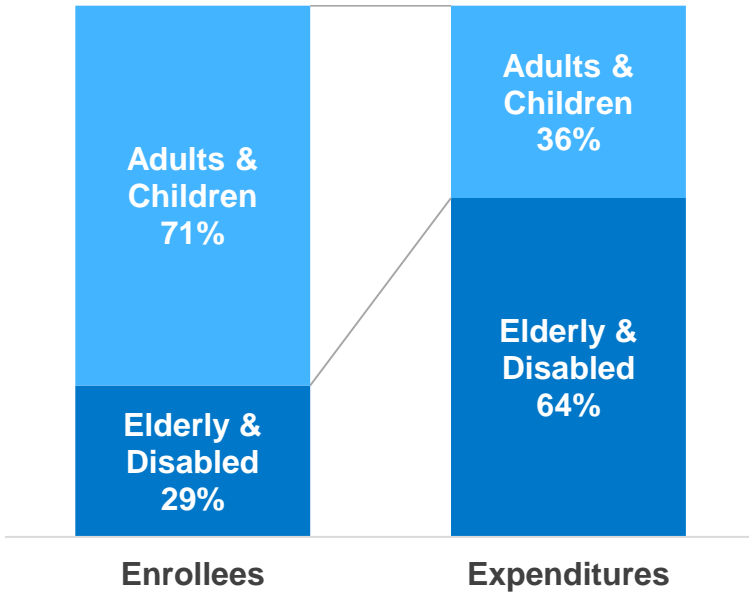

## FL Median Eligibility Levels

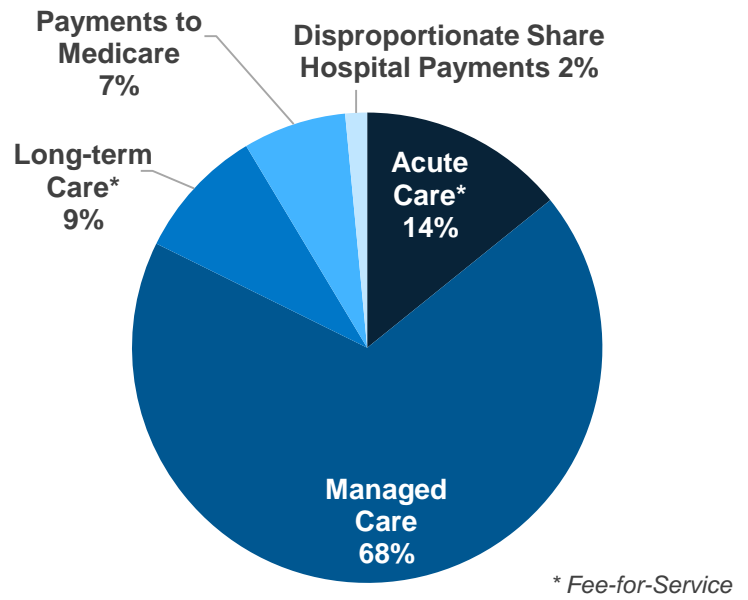

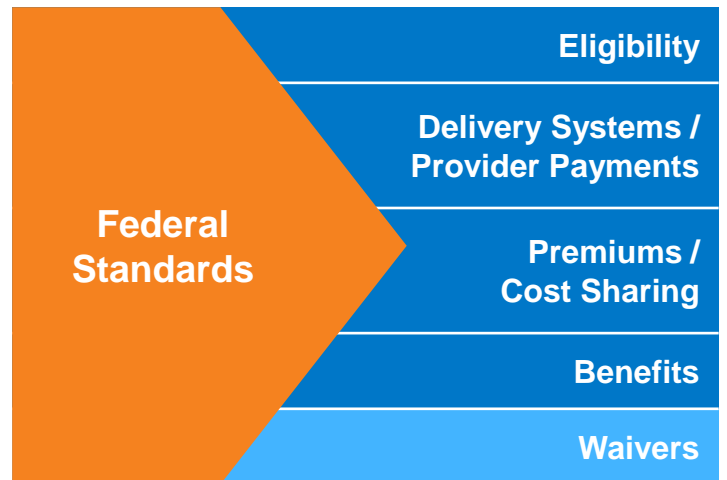

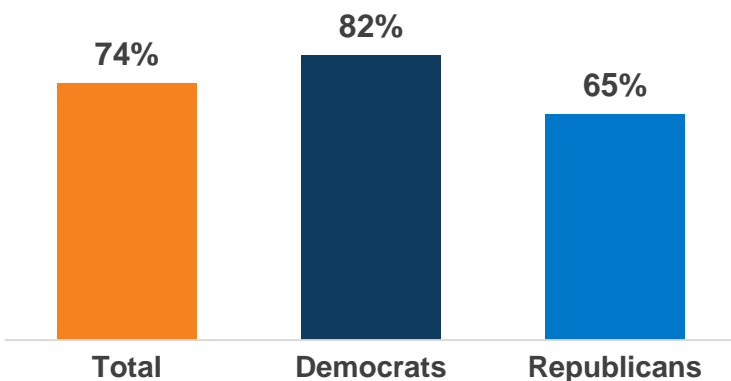
