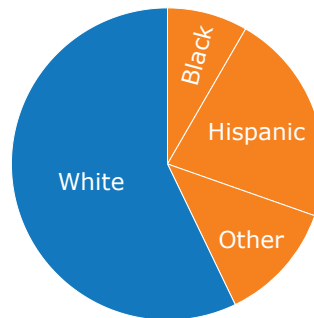

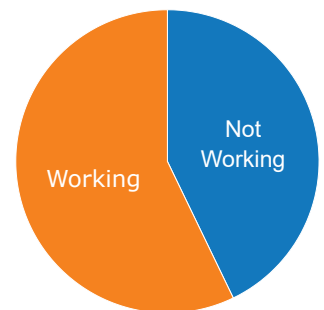

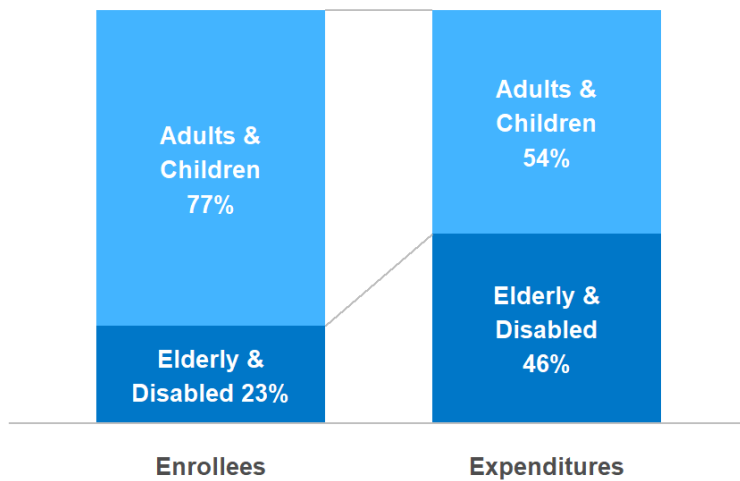

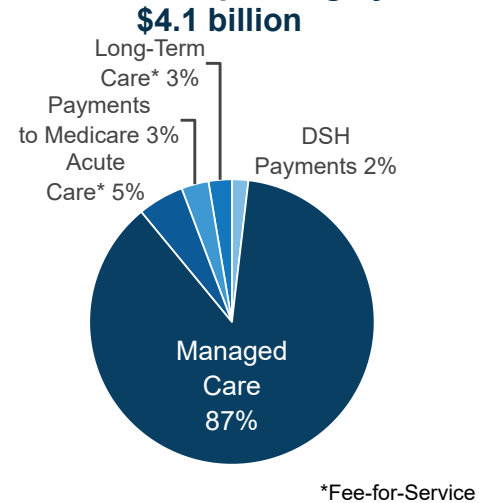

Medicaid Enrollees & Expenditures in KS

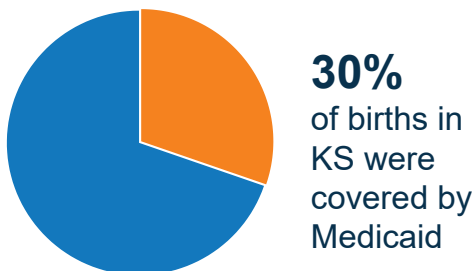
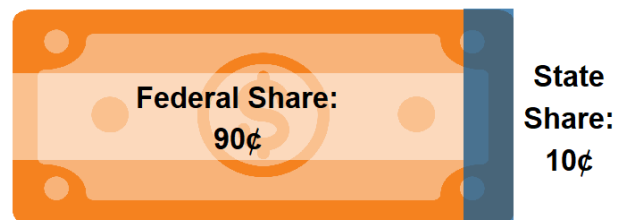
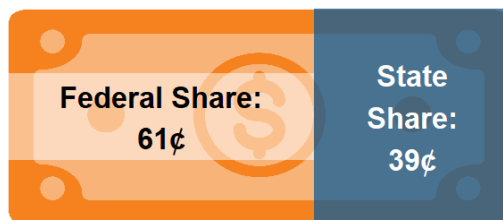


Total KS Medicaid Spending by Service: \$4.1 billion



In KS, the federal government pays **61%** of the cost of traditional Medicaid plus a 5 percentage point increase tied to the unwinding of the continuous enrollment provision that phases down and ends on December 31st, 2023

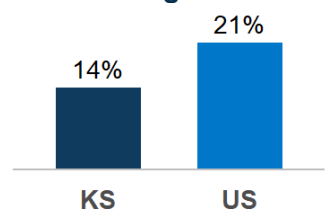
If KS expanded Medicaid, the federal government would pay **90%** of the costs of the Medicaid expansion, plus KS would see a net gain of **\$250 million** over 2 years in ARPA fiscal incentive payments



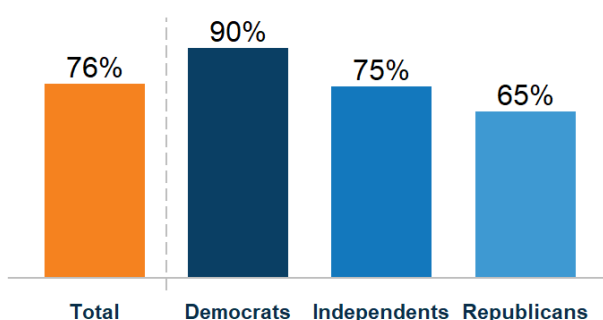
Kansas **has adopted** the Medicaid 12-month postpartum coverage extension
