Eligibility Levels as a % of FPL*



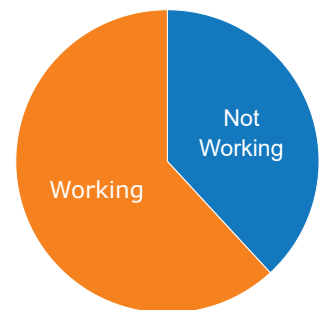

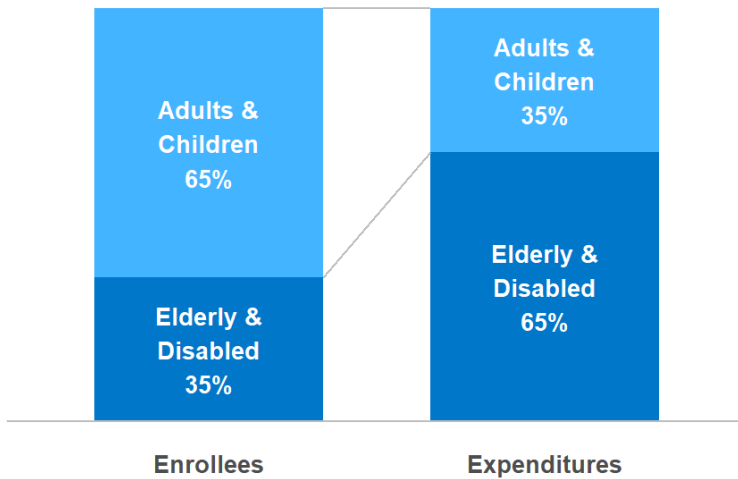

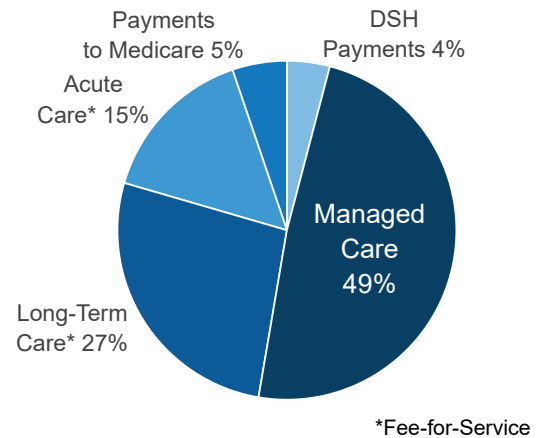

Medicaid Enrollees & Expenditures in MS

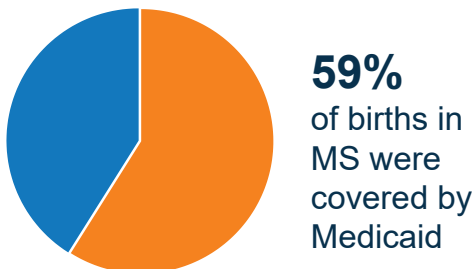
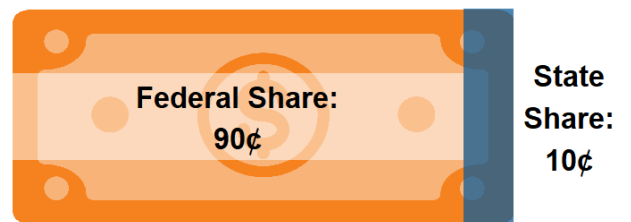


Total MS Medicaid Spending by Service: \$5.8 billion



In MS, the federal government pays **77%** of the cost of traditional Medicaid plus a 5 percentage point increase tied to the unwinding of the continuous enrollment provision that phases down and ends on December 31st, 2023

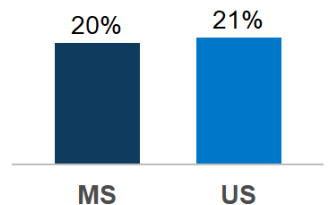
If MS expanded Medicaid, the federal government would pay **90%** of the costs of the Medicaid expansion, plus MS would see a net gain of **\$400 million** over 2 years in ARPA fiscal incentive payments



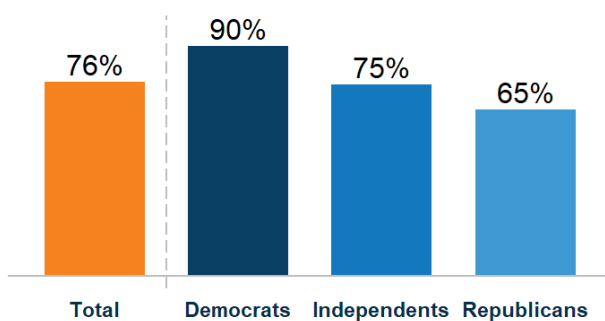
Mississippi **has adopted** the Medicaid 12-month postpartum coverage extension
