## Medicaid Enrollees & Expenditures in SC

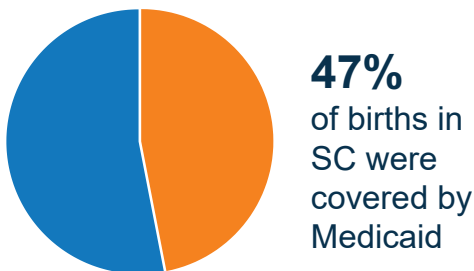
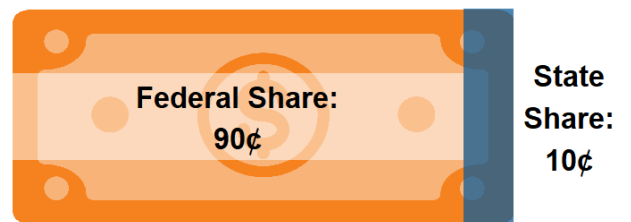
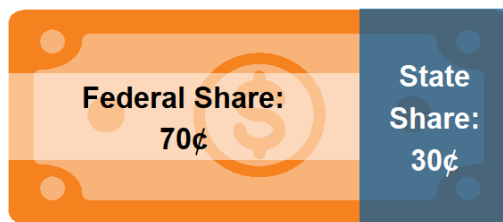


## Total SC Medicaid Spending by Service: \$7.2 billion



In SC, the federal government pays **70%** of the cost of traditional Medicaid plus a 5 percentage point increase tied to the unwinding of the continuous enrollment provision that phases down and ends on December 31st, 2023

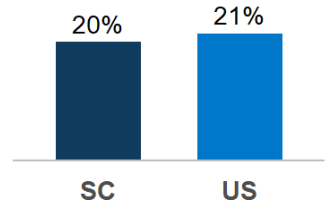
If SC expanded Medicaid, the federal government would pay **90%** of the costs of the Medicaid expansion, plus SC would see a net gain of **\$600 million** over 2 years in ARPA fiscal incentive payments



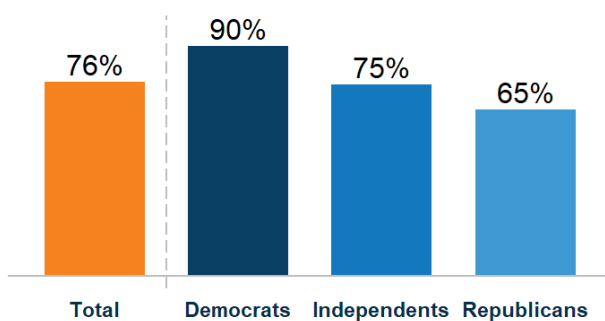
South Carolina **has adopted** the Medicaid 12-month postpartum coverage extension
