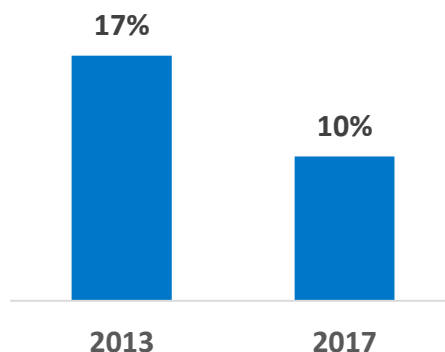

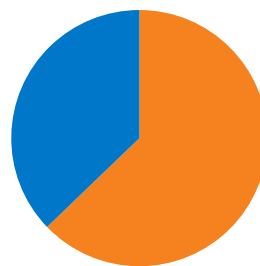

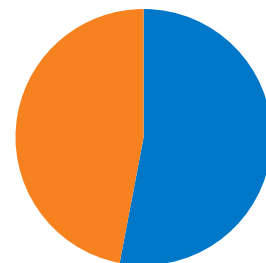

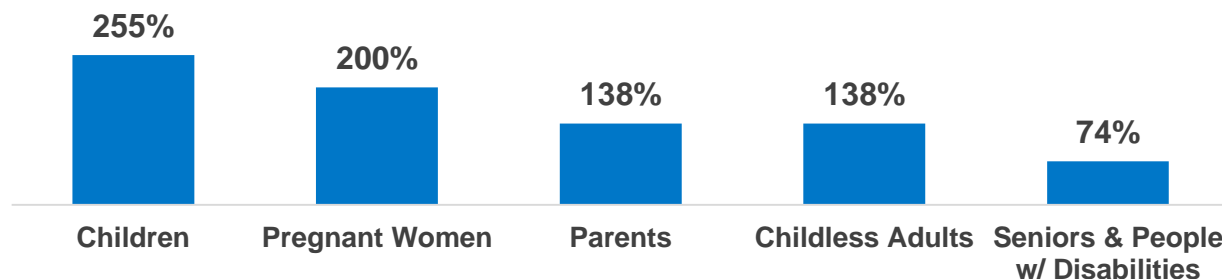

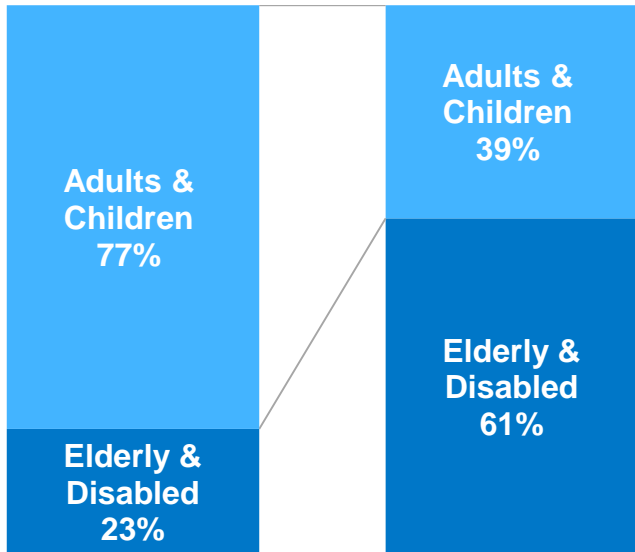

(as a % of FPL)



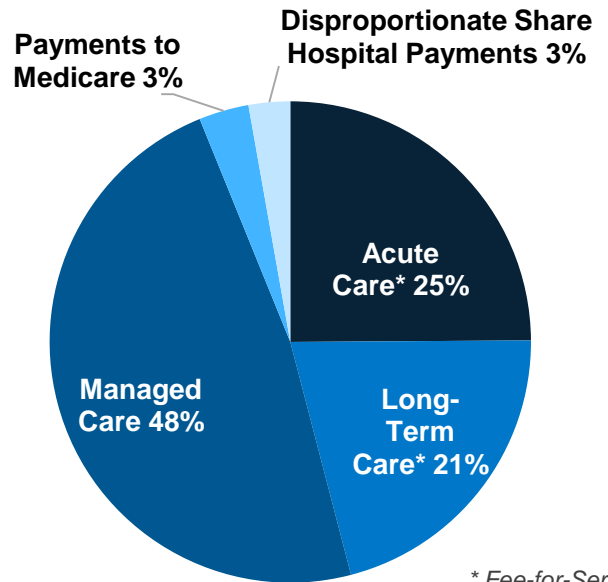

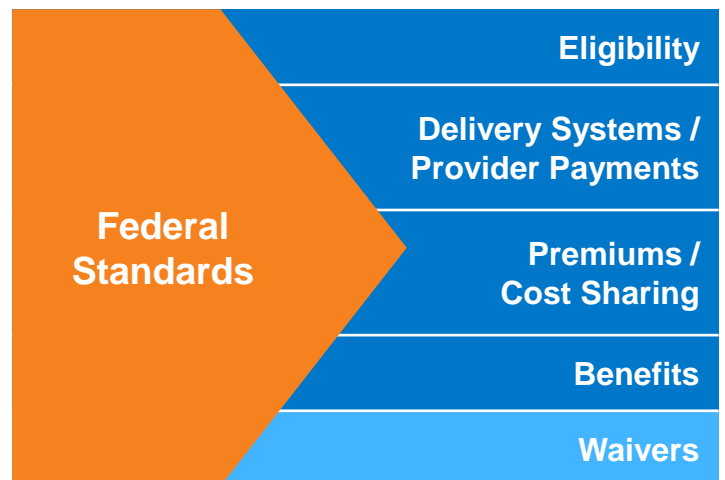

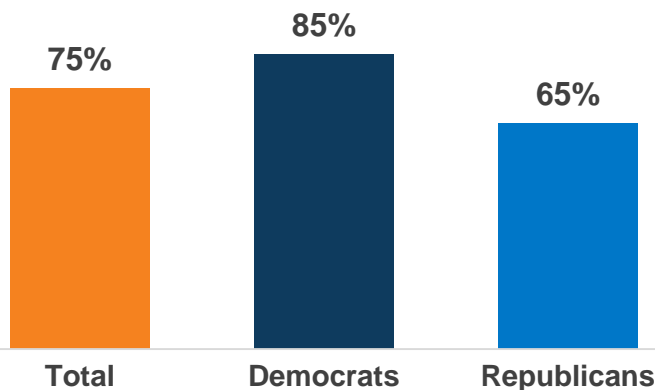
