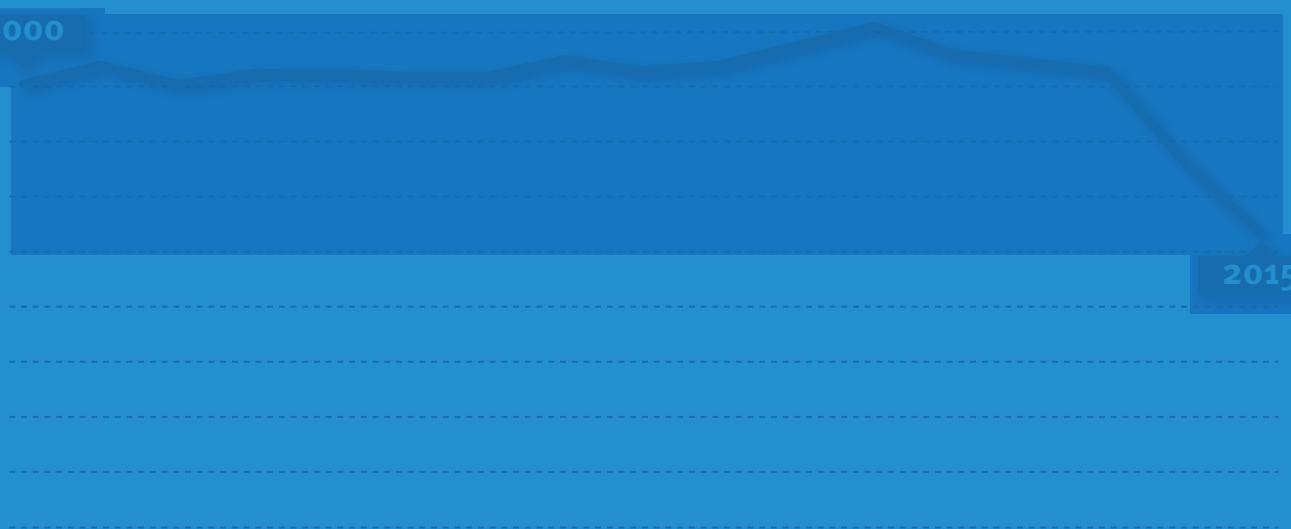

These tables provide detailed information about health insurance coverage among the U.S. nonelderly population in 2014. The data in the tables is based on analysis of the Census Bureau's March Supplement to the Current Population Survey (the CPS Annual Social and Economic Supplement or ASEC) by the Kaiser Family Foundation.

Detailed national tables examine health insurance coverage and characteristics of the uninsured population by key social and economic determinants, including:

- Age
- Gender
- Family income and poverty levels
- Household type
- Family work status
- Education
- Race/ethnicity
- Citizenship
- Health status

National tables are provided for the total nonelderly population, with additional separate tables for these groups:

- Children
- Nonelderly adults
- Nonelderly adult women
- Nonelderly adult men
- Young adults (age 19-25)
- Nonelderly below poverty (<100% FPL)
- Poor and Low-income Nonelderly (<200% FPL)

In addition, two national tables describe health insurance coverage among nonelderly adult workers (age 19-64) and examine uninsured nonelderly adult workers by these additional factors:

- Work status
- Business size
- Occupation
- Industry

Last, two tables describe the populations of remaining uninsured nonelderly and nonelderly adults by state Medicaid expansion status.
