

Key Findings on the Experiences and Attitudes of Black Adults in the U.S.

Overall



Say it is a **bad time to be a Black man** in America (among Black men)



Say it is a **bad time to be a Black woman** in America (among Black women)



Have been **treated unfairly because of their race** in the past 12 months while shopping, working, interacting with police, or getting health care



Say **systemic or structural racism is a major obstacle** to Black people achieving equal outcomes with White people

COVID-19

Someone in household lost a job, was furloughed, or had their hours/income reduced as a result of pandemic	51%
Pandemic has had a major negative impact on ability to pay for necessities	32 %
Feel the government's pandemic response would be stronger if White people were getting sick and dying at higher rates than people of color	66%
Not confident that coronavirus vaccine development is taking the needs of Black people into account	65%
Would not get a coronavirus vaccine if determined to be safe by scientists and available for free	49%

Health Care



Say the **health care system often treats people unfairly** based on their race or ethnic background

Say it is difficult to find a doctor who shares their background and experience

48% Say it is difficult to find health care they can afford

Have personally been treated unfairly based on their race while getting health care for themselves or a family member in the past 12 months
