Table 18 Notes

States that contract with Medicaid managed care organizations (MCOs) can engage them in conducting outreach and assisting enrollees with renewals. States may provide MCOs with advance lists of members up for renewal, at risk of being disenrolled for procedural reasons, or who are ineligible and may need assistance transitioning to other sources of coverage. States can also accept updated contact information provided by MCOs without requiring further verification by the state, as allowed under Section 1902(e)(14) temporary waiver authority. This list is published by CMS on Medicaid.gov.

NR indicates the state did not report.

N/A indicates the state uses a fee-for-service model and does not contract with MCOs.
