



A majority (74%) of Medicaid adults are working in Delaware

Medicaid eligibility limits as a percent of the federal poverty level (FPL)*




*The FPL in 2025 is \$26,650 for a family of three and \$15,650 for an individual.


**To qualify for Medicaid at the higher income eligibility levels, individuals must meet requirements for the buy-in program for working age people with disabilities.



Total Medicaid spending in Delaware is \$3.3 billion




Financing for Medicaid is shared by states and the federal government; Delaware receives \$2.4 billion in federal Medicaid funding

In Delaware Medicaid, people ages 65+ and people with disabilities are 16% of enrollees but account for 40% of spending




Per enrollee Medicaid spending is higher for individuals receiving home care
