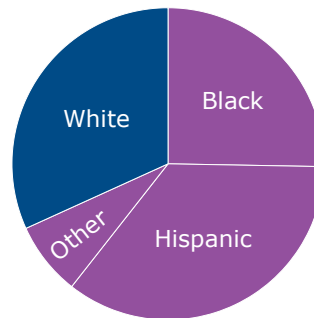

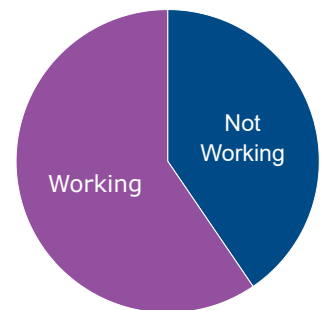

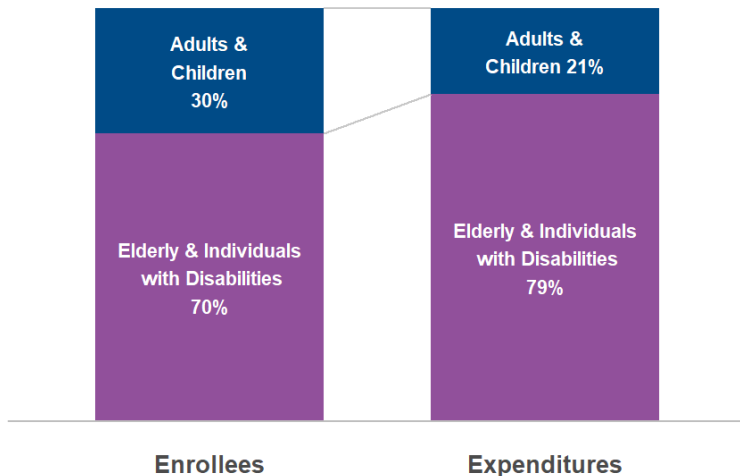

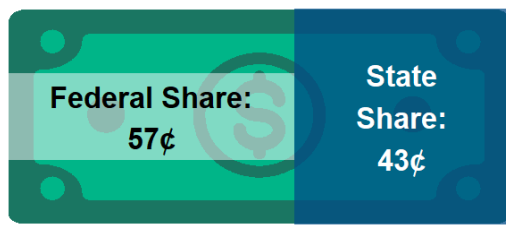
Medicaid Enrollees & Expenditures in FL



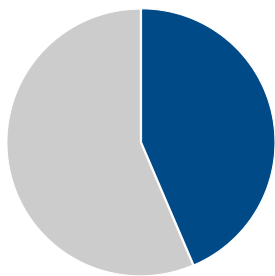
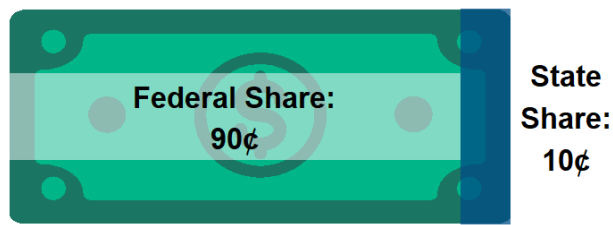
Total FL Medicaid Spending by Service: \$33.1 billion



In FL, the federal government pays **57%** of the cost of traditional Medicaid.



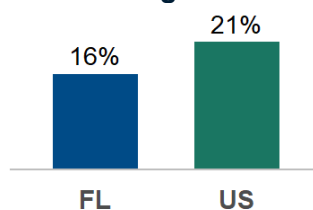

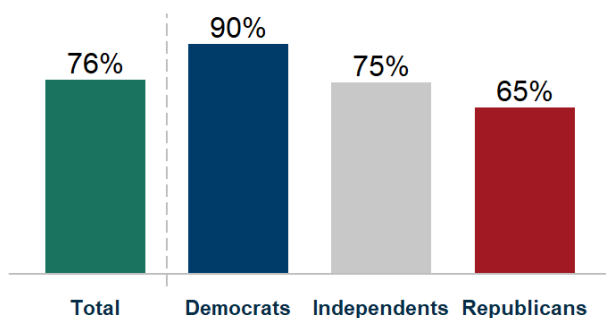
