**2 in 5 (42%)** are children

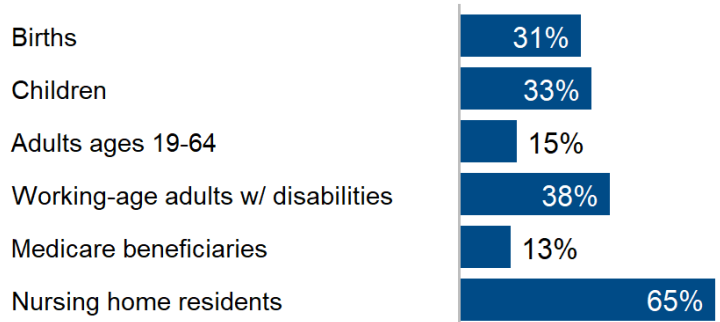
**3 in 8 (35%)** live in a rural area

**1 in 8 (12%)** have three or more chronic conditions

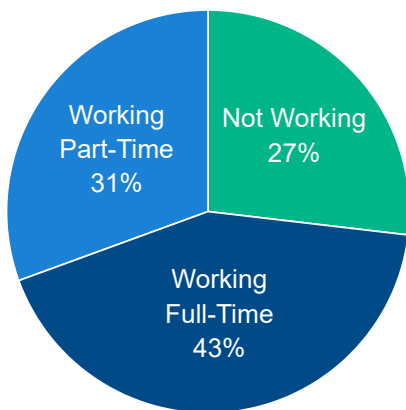

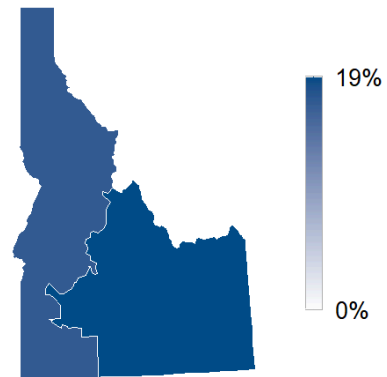

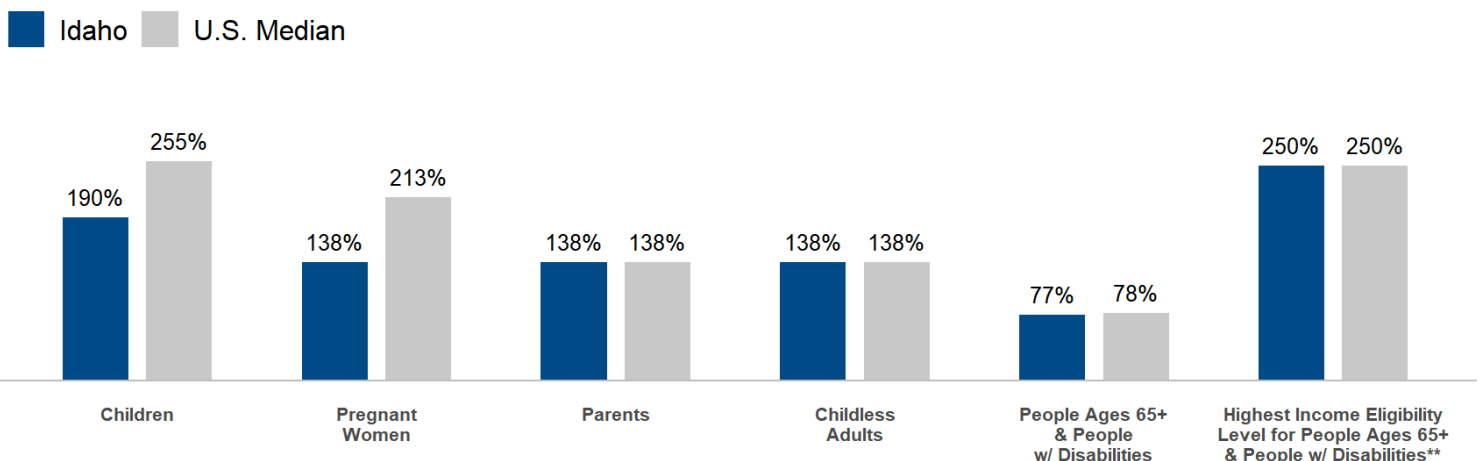
## A majority (74%) of Medicaid adults are working in Idaho



## Medicaid covers from 17% to 19% of people in ID's congressional districts



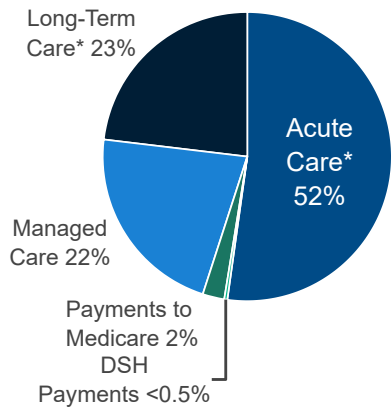
## Medicaid eligibility limits as a percent of the federal poverty level (FPL)\*



\*The FPL in 2025 is \$26,650 for a family of three and \$15,650 for an individual.

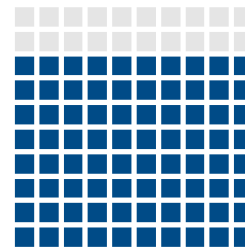
\*\*To qualify for Medicaid at the higher income eligibility levels, individuals must meet requirements for the buy-in program for working age people with disabilities.

**Total Medicaid spending in Idaho is \$3.6 billion**



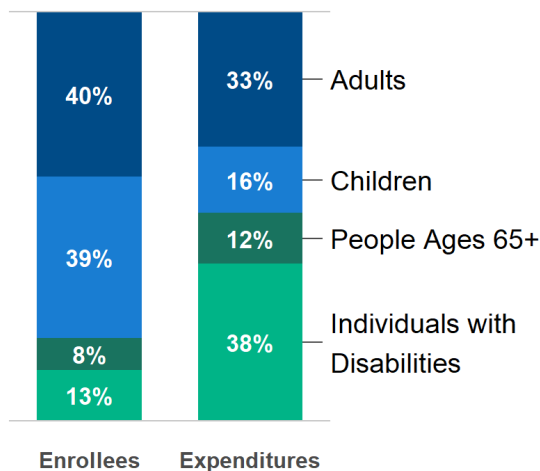

**Financing for Medicaid is shared by states and the federal government; Idaho receives \$2.9 billion in federal Medicaid funding**



Federal funding is **80%** of total Medicaid spending in Idaho

**In Idaho Medicaid, people ages 65+ and people with disabilities are 21% of enrollees but account for 50% of spending**

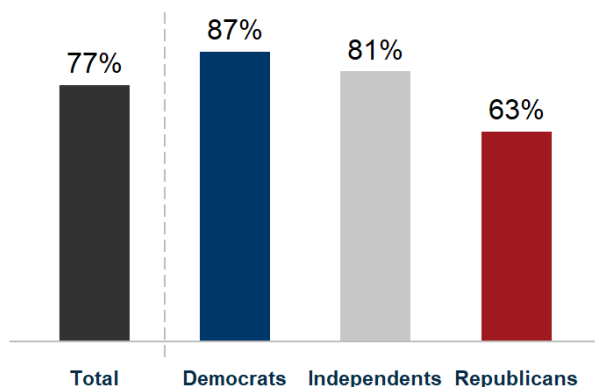


**Per enrollee Medicaid spending is higher for individuals receiving institutional care**
