**3 in 8 (36%)** are children

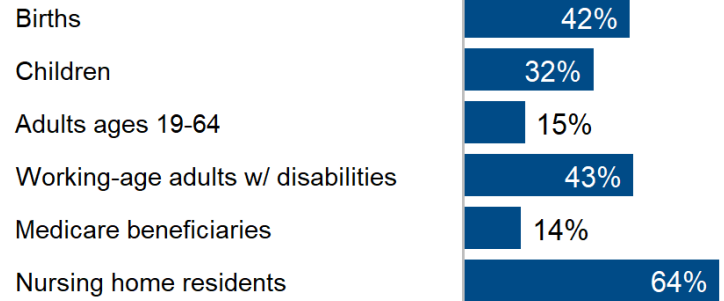
**1 in 25 (4%)** live in a rural area

**1 in 6 (17%)** have three or more chronic conditions

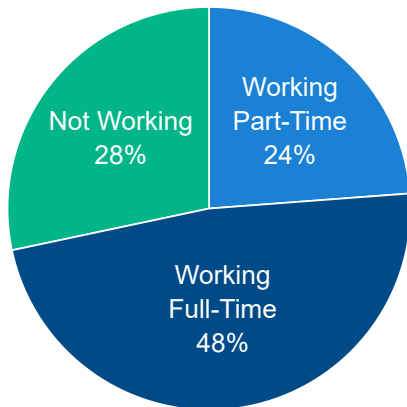

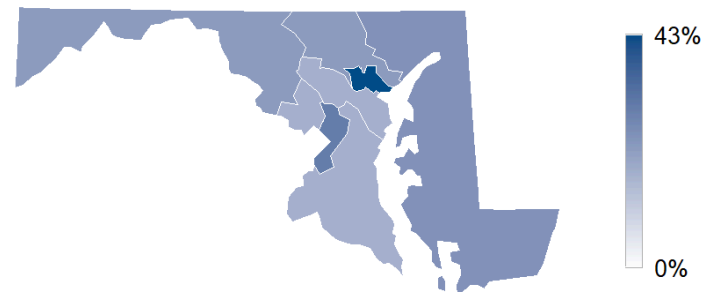
## In Maryland, Medicaid covers...



## A majority (72%) of Medicaid adults are working in Maryland

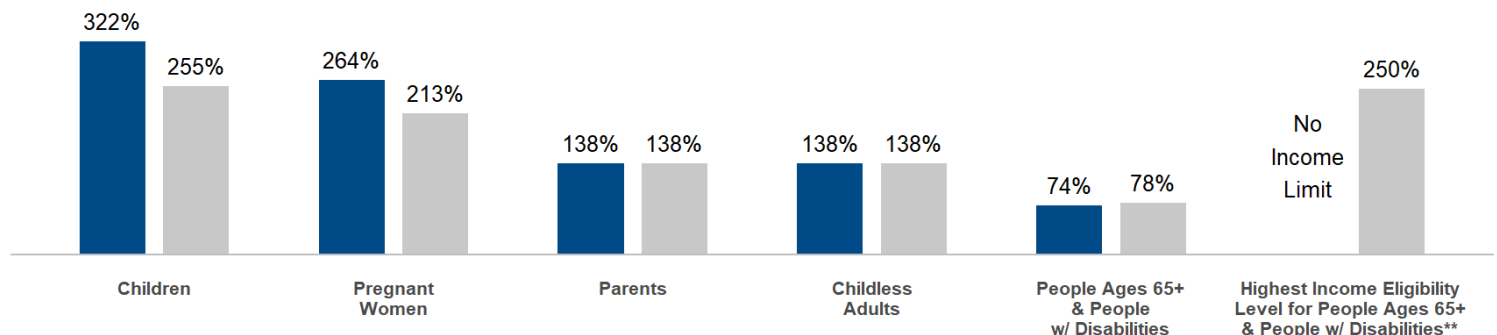


## Medicaid covers from 17% to 43% of people in MD's congressional districts



## Medicaid eligibility limits as a percent of the federal poverty level (FPL)\*

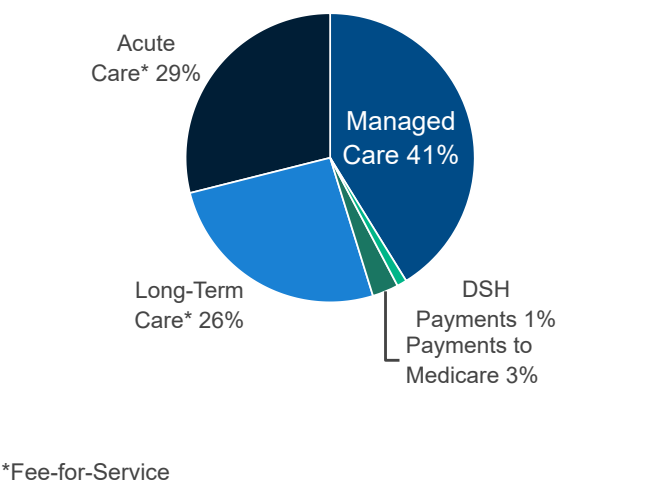

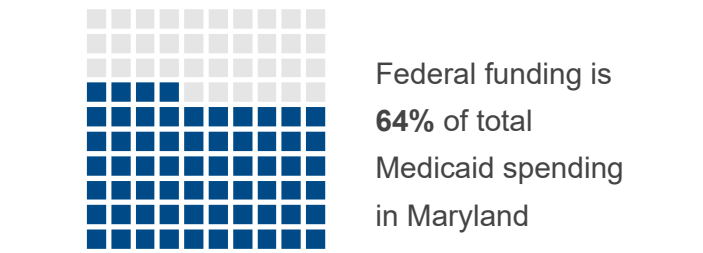
\*The FPL in 2025 is \$26,650 for a family of three and \$15,650 for an individual.

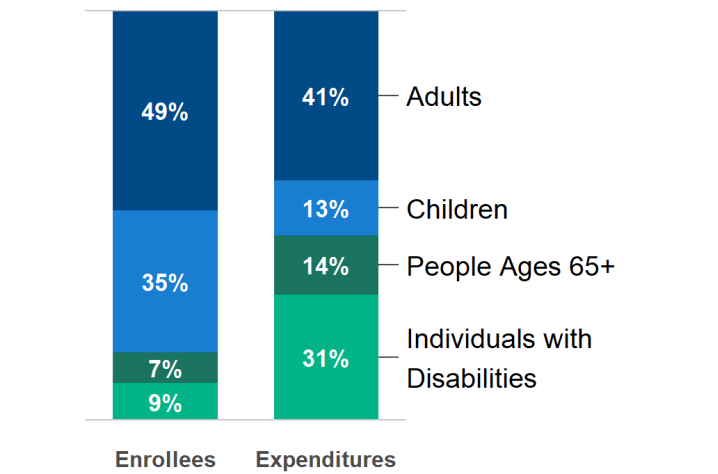
Total Medicaid spending in Maryland is \$17 billion



Financing for Medicaid is shared by states and the federal government; Maryland receives \$10.8 billion in federal Medicaid funding



In Maryland Medicaid, people ages 65+ and people with disabilities are 16% of enrollees but account for 45% of spending

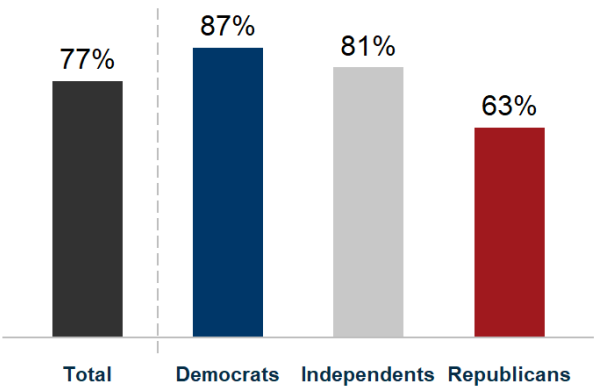


Per enrollee Medicaid spending is higher for individuals receiving institutional care
