2 in 7 (28%) are children

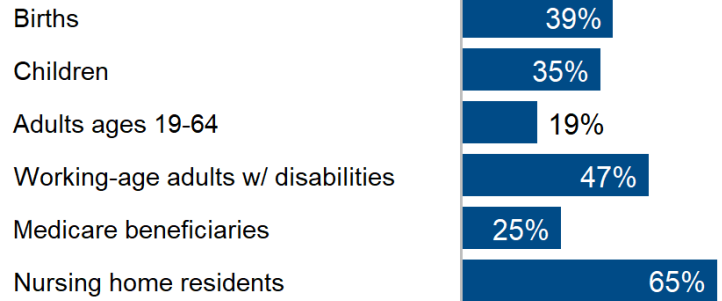
1 in 2 (52%) live in a rural area

1 in 6 (16%) have three or more chronic conditions

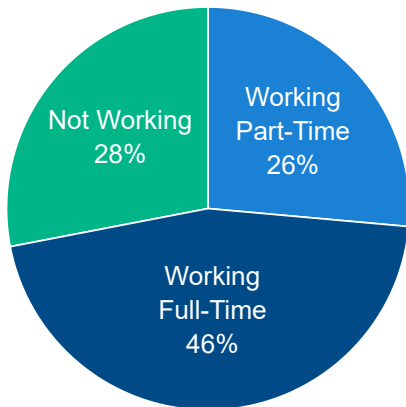

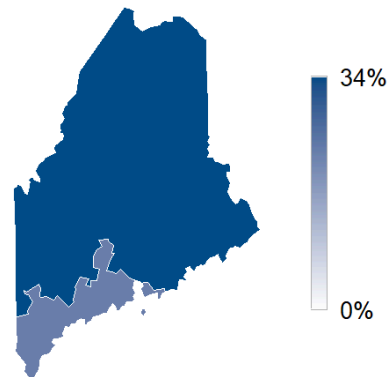
In Maine, Medicaid covers...



A majority (72%) of Medicaid adults are working in Maine

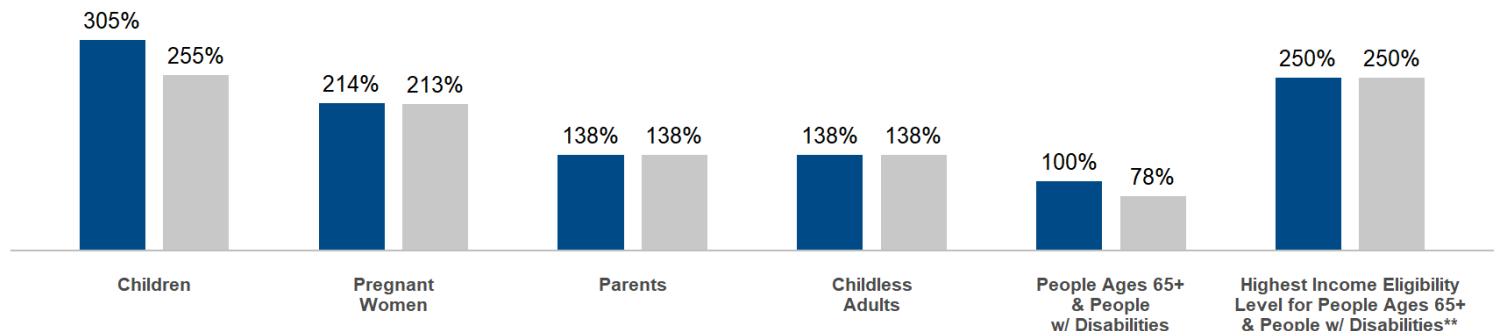


Medicaid covers from 23% to 34% of people in ME's congressional districts



Medicaid eligibility limits as a percent of the federal poverty level (FPL)*

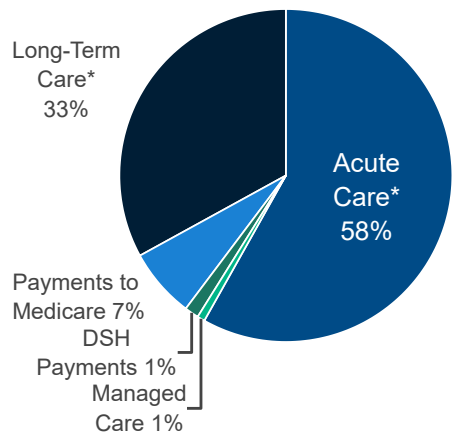

*The FPL in 2025 is \$26,650 for a family of three and \$15,650 for an individual.

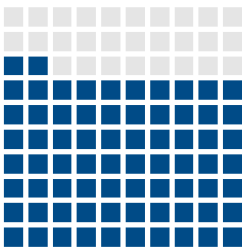
**To qualify for Medicaid at the higher income eligibility levels, individuals must meet requirements for the buy-in program for working age people with disabilities.

Total Medicaid spending in Maine is \$4.2 billion



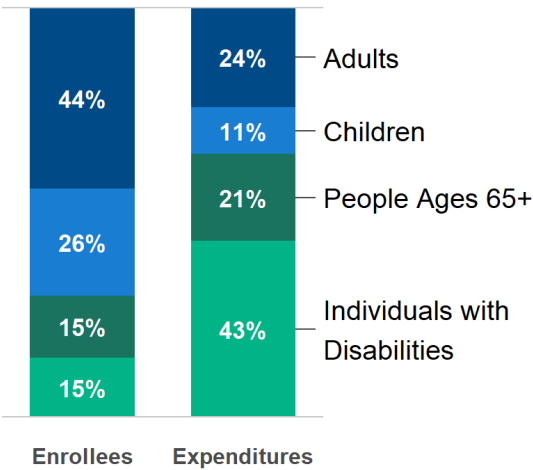

Financing for Medicaid is shared by states and the federal government; Maine receives \$3 billion in federal Medicaid funding



Federal funding is 72% of total Medicaid spending in Maine

In Maine Medicaid, people ages 65+ and people with disabilities are 30% of enrollees but account for 64% of spending

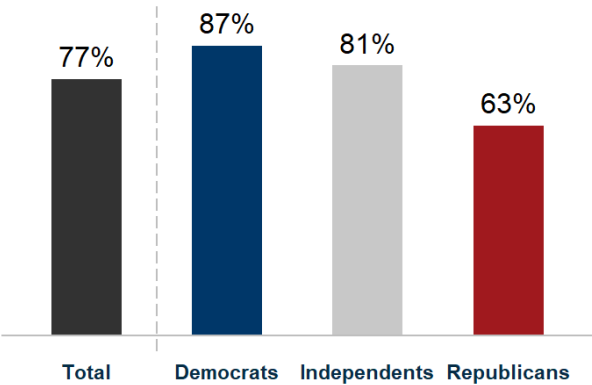


Per enrollee Medicaid spending is higher for individuals receiving home care
