





#### Medicaid eligibility limits as a percent of the federal poverty level (FPL)\*



### Total Medicaid spending in Rhode Island is \$3.5 billion





# In Rhode Island Medicaid, people ages 65+ and people with disabilities are 22% of enrollees but account for 50% of spending


