- 1 in 8 (13%) have three or more chronic conditions

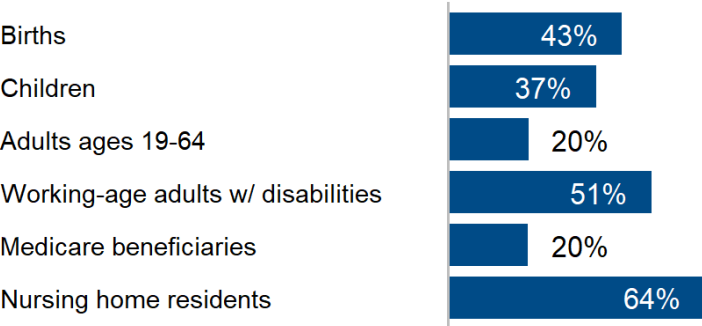

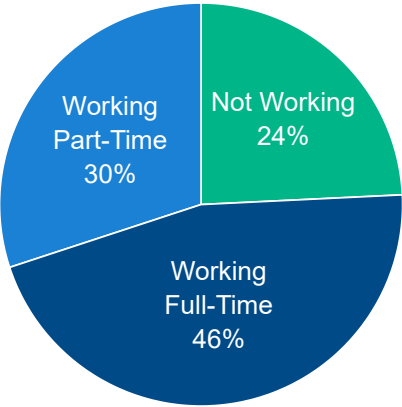

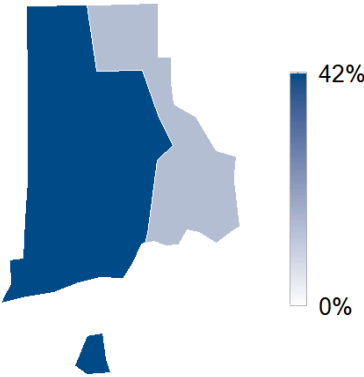
In Rhode Island, Medicaid covers...



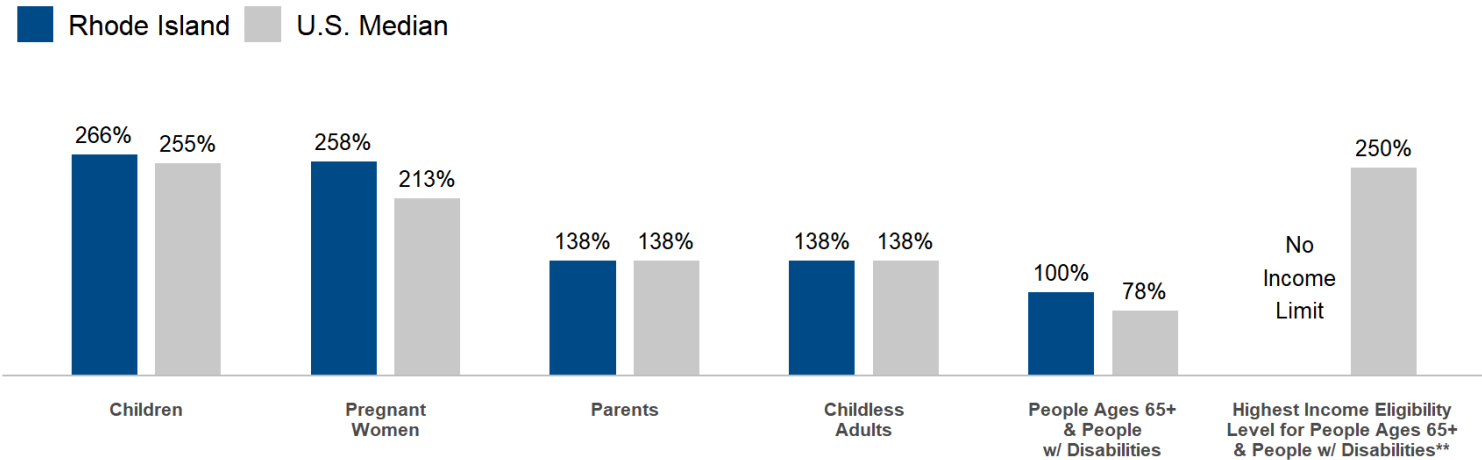
A majority (76%) of Medicaid adults are working in Rhode Island



Medicaid covers from 14% to 42% of people in RI's congressional districts

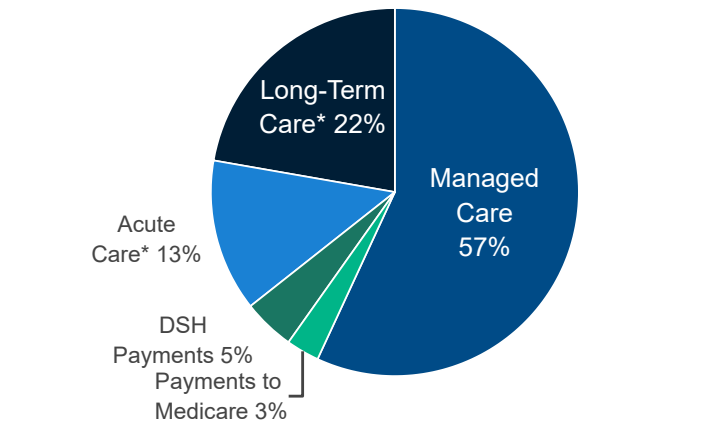


Medicaid eligibility limits as a percent of the federal poverty level (FPL)\*



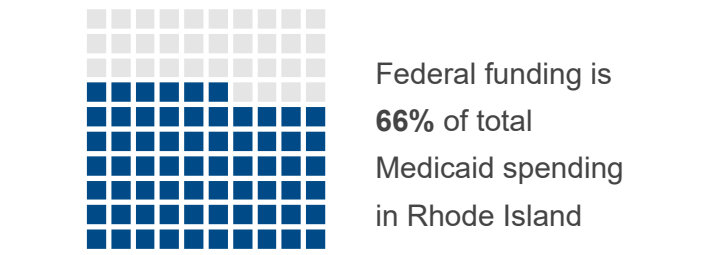
\*The FPL in 2025 is \$26,650 for a family of three and \$15,650 for an individual.

Total Medicaid spending in Rhode Island is \$3.5 billion

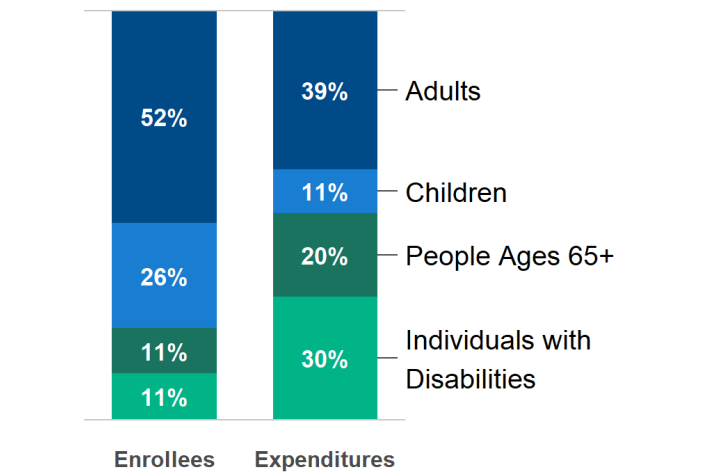

In Rhode Island Medicaid, people ages 65+ and people with disabilities are 22% of enrollees but account for 50% of spending

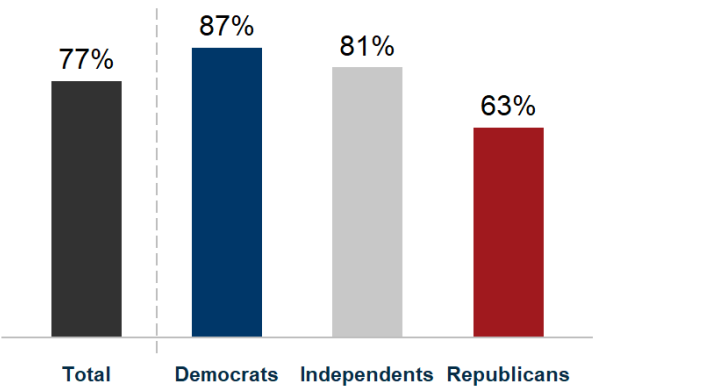


Per enrollee Medicaid spending is higher for individuals receiving institutional care
