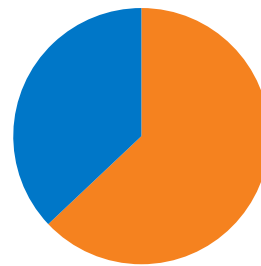

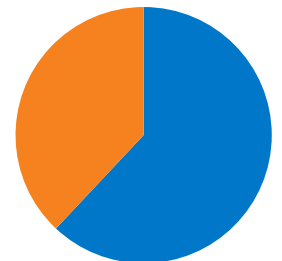

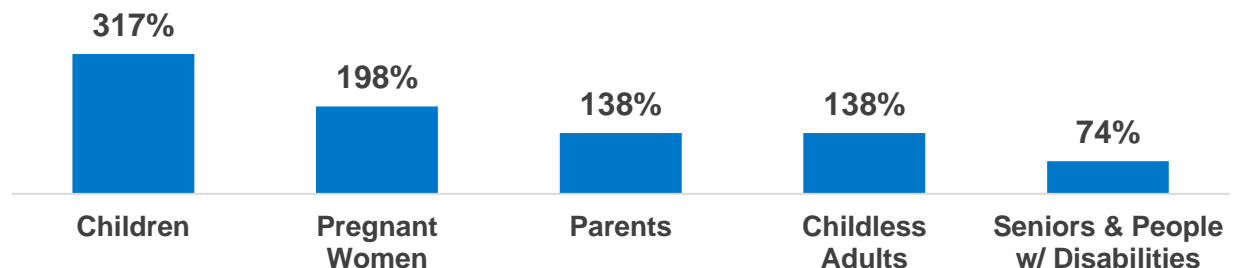

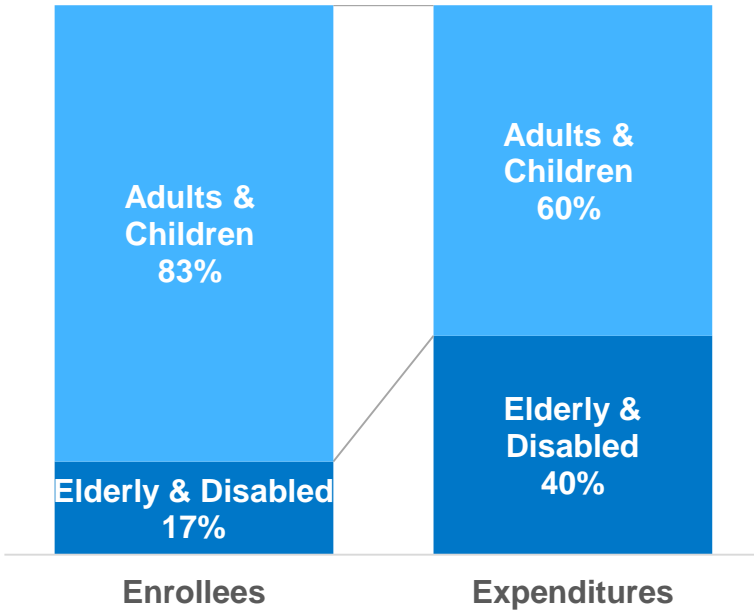

WA Eligibility Levels

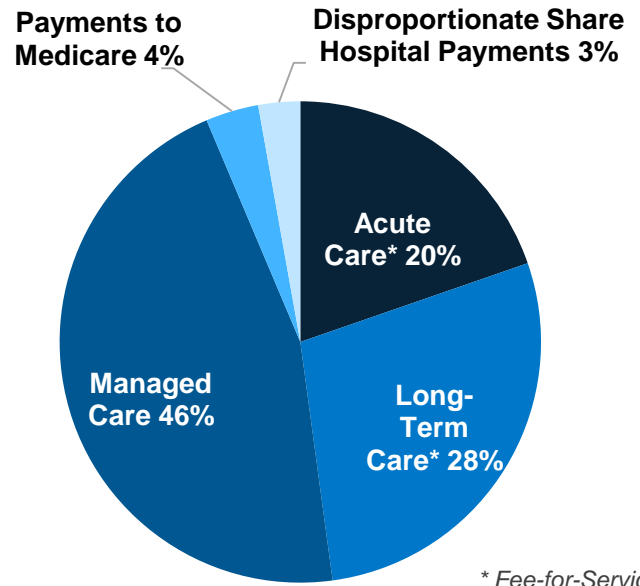

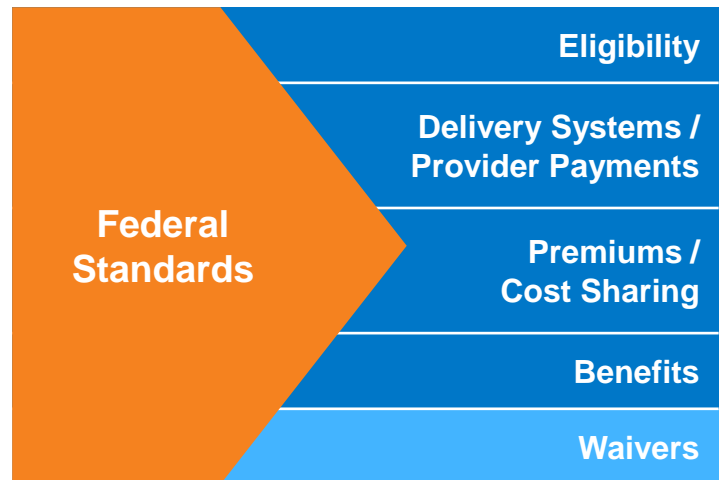

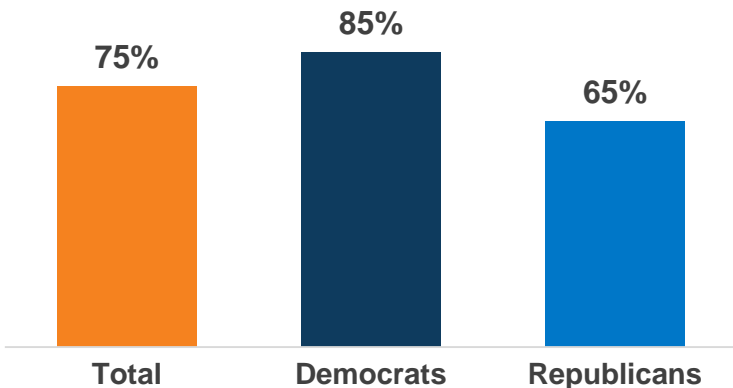
