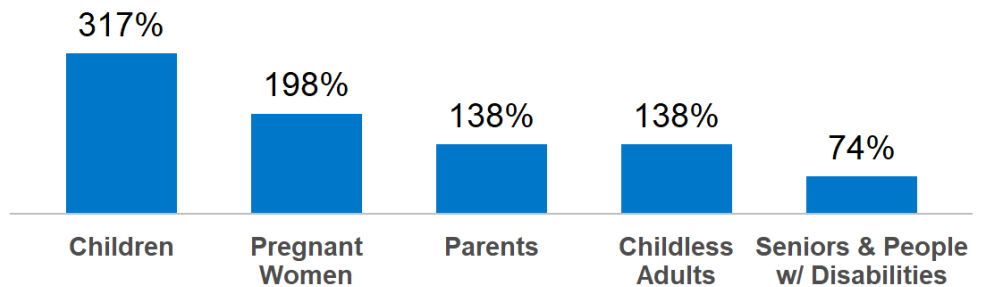

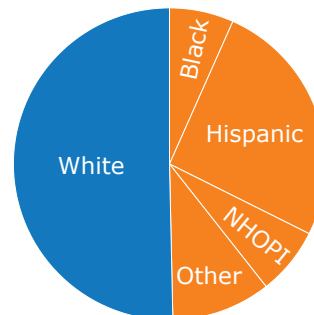

### Eligibility Levels as a % of FPL\*



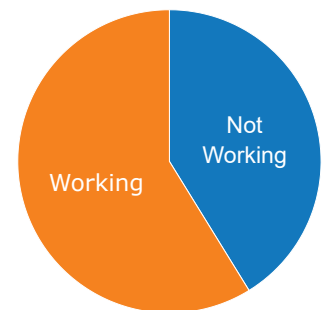

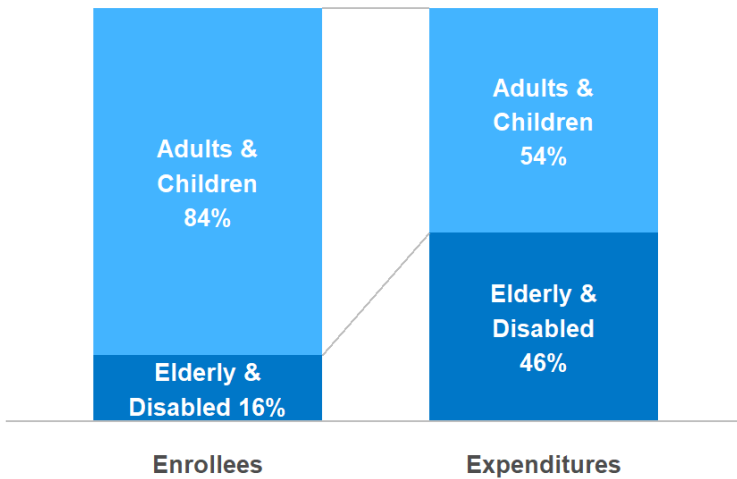

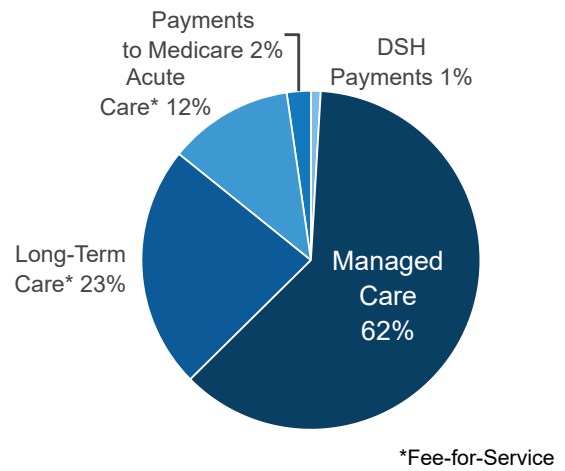

## Medicaid Enrollees & Expenditures in WA



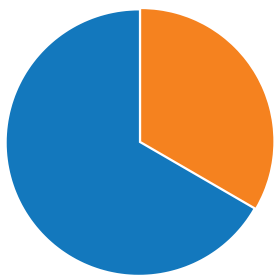
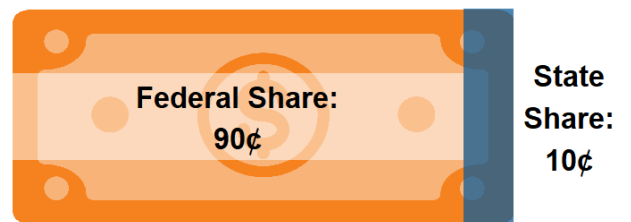
## Total WA Medicaid Spending by Service: \$21.9 billion



In WA, the federal government pays **50%** of the cost of traditional Medicaid plus a 5 percentage point increase tied to the unwinding of the continuous enrollment provision that phases down and ends on December 31st, 2023



The federal government pays **90%** of the cost of the Medicaid expansion

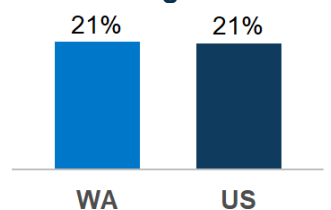

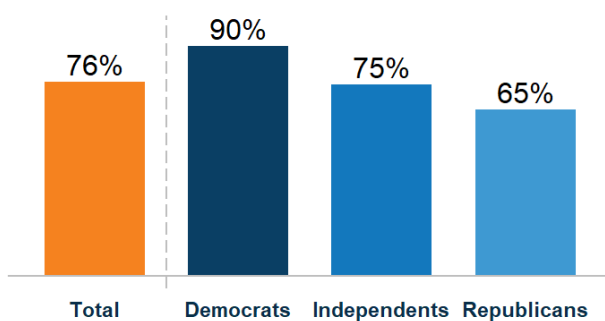
